Girls 14-17

A Girl Scout **Gold** Award Project can make a lasting change for the better in your community. Not only will you gain a personal sense of accomplishment and benefit your community, but you will also be joining a network of tens of thousands of powerful and accomplished women who have earned Girl Scouting's highest honor. You'll find that colleges and universities, businesses, and your community recognize the effort and leadership you have demonstrated. In fact, some colleges/universities offer scholarships to girls who have earned their Girl Scout **Gold** Award.

Guidelines

The Girl Scout **Gold** Award is the highest achievement for Girl Scouts ages 14–18 or in grades 9–12.

- You can do steps 1–4 when you are 14–18 or in grades 9–12.
- You can do steps 5–7 when you are 15–18, or in grades 10–12.
- You will use the Girl Scout **Gold** Award Insert “Go for It!”.
- You will track what you do in the spaces provided in the insert.
- You will design and lead a project that takes at least **65 hours** to complete, including “planning and doing”.
- You will present to an opening and closing panel.
- You will submit a project proposal and final paperwork to GSJTC Councilwide Service Center.
